Curriculum & Pedagogical Innovations











One of our most transformative developments has been the creation of a lush, grass-covered outdoor learning area, designed to be accessible in all weather conditions. We've introduced a blackboard wall, turning an ordinary boundary into a space for spontaneous writing, drawing, and collaborative learning.

To nurture creativity and motor skills, we've built a soil play zone where children can dig, build sandcastles, and connect with nature through tactile exploration. Our multi-play station is thoughtfully designed, ranging from gentle swings for younger children to an 11 -foot slide for the more adventurous. Each play elementbe it the calisthenics zone or sensory area-has been chosen to support a specific set of developmental skills.

VCA's dynamic house system, infuses everyday learning with a spirit of healthy competition, teamwork, and belonging. Students are encouraged and mandated to participate across a range of sports activities, cultural pursuits and performance-based activities through a structured participation model.

Our much-anticipated Sports Week, which spans three exciting days, features inter-house competitions and talent identification for school teams. Alongside, we run a rich calendar of literary events, performing arts competitions, and creative showcases—from debates and dramatics to dance, music, and public speaking are to name a few.

The school encourages holistic development through active student participation in various activities. This year, 85 students represented at the state level and 20 at the national level. 

Rain Water Harvesting

The school has three rainwater harvesting wells, each storing up to 1,500 litres. These fill during rains and help recharge the groundwater naturally.

Waste Segregation & Composting

We use four color-coded dustbins-yellow, black, green, and blue-for proper waste segregation. Bio degradable waste goes into a compost pit, producing natural fertilizer. Students are taught these eco-friendly practices.

Grey Water Recycling

Wastewater from drains is collected in a tank and reused to water plants, reducing water wastage and promoting sustainability.
